Energy for Regional Australia

Australians living in regional and remote communities are often faced with the challenge of travelling long distances to access essential products and services.

For some, this means driving up to 100Km just to fuel up their car. IOR believes that regional and remote Australian communities would benefit from more affordable and more accessible energy sources. In this regard, IOR is bringing Australians convenience and choice in relation to accessing fuel through the IOR Diesel Network.

The IOR Diesel Network of unmanned 24/7 diesel stops aims to serve Australia's long-haul transport industry. The roads travelled by these operators often connect regional and remote communities and it is in many of these locations that IOR has established an outlet.

The current goals of IOR's Energy for Regional Australia program are to:

- Make access to fuel more convenient for regional and remote Australian communities.
- Increase competition in the regional and remote fuel market, making fuel more affordable for Australian consumers.
