## **Background**

Sea World Helicopters offer premium tours of the Gold Coast and charters throughout and beyond South East Queensland. The fleet of AS350 helicopters accommodate up to 6 passengers per aircraft and depart from Australia's largest privately-owned heliport.

In 2019, Sea World Helicopters was looking to increase the size and improve the effectiveness of its fuel system and sought a custom solution from IOR as their existing fuel supplier.

The modern facility also features IOR's proprietary fuel management system, HyDip®, which provides Sea World Helicopters with real-time visibility on their fuel tank levels and complete oversight of aircraft fuel usage.

#### How IOR Added Value

Commissioned in 2019, the new 30,000L Jet A1 facility tripled Sea World Helicopters' fuel storage capacity and enables continuous safe refuelling for the fleet.

"This new system has fundamentally changed the way we manage our fuel supply,"

"For me, one of the biggest benefits is the ability to monitor usage remotely at any time using the HyDip® system. With HyDip®, I don't have to physically check the tanks and I can get up to the minute, accurate data for our records based on the usage of each helicopter. The move away from the old manual system has streamlined our processes."
